Now's your opportunity to bid on the chance to attend one or more of these fabulous events! All events take place between mid-May and November 2013.

(rolling close starts at approx. 12:30pm)

If you've participated in other silent auctions before, you've most likely bid to buy the whole event. In Gourmets for God, you're bidding for **one seat or spot**. (If the event takes six guests then you are bidding to be one of six guests. Bid for more than one seat if you want to bring a friend or partner. Some events have Family Pricing and the bid is per spot and allows for more than one guest per spot. See those events for specific details.)

There is no limit to how many events for which you can bid – however, your bid is financially binding and you will be invoiced for all events you do win. Of course, you do not need to be a CSL member to participate!

Also note, this year we will have a special table just for events that will be especially suitable for families with children – look for it!

Have fun! Eat well! Bid early and bid often!

Registration

Oncampus

Register and submit a valid credit card at the auction registration table to receive a bidding number. Volunteers can explain the financial guidelines for participating in the auction.


Online

Set up your Bidding Profile, which will enable you to bid on events and keep track of them. Visit our online auction page, starting with the URL above. When you see this auction item: **Set Up Your Bidding Profile**, click on the **View/Bid** button to the right. Next click on the **Sign-In/Register to Bid** button. You will be prompted through the registration process and receive a confirmation email and a bidding number from our Silent Auction Team once you are approved.

ONLINE bidding works like this:

Bid online by 9pm on Wed, April 17, 2013. The software will keep track of the winning bids.

Within the online auction, the highest bid at 9pm on April 17 is the winner for that seat/spot. **Once the online auction closes, all remaining seats/spots will be added to the oncampus auction final bidding session, 8:30am to 1:00pm, Sunday, April 21.** (Rolling close starts at approx. 12:30pm.)

ONCAMPUS bidding works like this:

Let's say you'd like to attend an Italian dinner for six people. Enter your bid on the bid sheet, keeping in mind the minimum bid as well as the bid increments of either \$2 or \$5. If you *really* want to attend this dinner, bid high, right from the start! Once six people have entered valid bids, the seventh bid will bump the **LAST lowest bidder** off the guest list. (In the case of a tie, the earliest bidder wins.) That's why it's a good idea to bid *early* and bid often! Keep checking the bid sheet—if you were outbid, counter with a higher bid **on a new line at the bottom of the list.*** In the end, the highest six bidders will have won seats/spots at the meal. All that's left to do is show up at the appointed time and place for a great time and great food!

** To help bidders keep track, a Gourmets for God volunteer will monitor the bid sheets during the bidding periods, crossing out bids that have become invalid by a higher bid.*

Oncampus and online bidding are separate!

Make sure that you don't bid for the same event online and oncampus – the seats/spots and bids are completely separate and you might win in both places! If you bid and win oncampus, as well as online, you are responsible for the bids on all seats/spots won.

Special pricing options

Look for the "special pricing" colored label on some bid sheets for great deals:

BUY IT NOW events

No bidding necessary – just enter your bid number on the bid sheet and you're good to go!

Family-pricing events

A certain number of children may attend, included in the price of one adult. Look for the special table just for these events at the oncampus silent auction!

Very important details

1. **Your bid is a contract.** Do not bid if you cannot pay to attend.
2. You must register and submit a valid credit card to receive a bidding number, either online or at the auction registration table. Your bidder number, unique to you, can be used both for oncampus and online bidding. **Bidding without one will void your bid.** Volunteers can explain the financial guidelines for participating in the auction.
3. Registering as a bidder does not obligate you to make a purchase. You will only be invoiced if you are a winning bidder.
4. Each bidder must bid on a separate line. If you are a couple or family, please use a separate line for each person. **We cannot add extra seats to an event if a couple's or family's bids are split,** so bid accordingly (i.e., high) if you really want all individuals to attend. The only exception is the family-pricing events – one line is a bid for the adult, who may bring as many children as indicated for that particular event.
5. When you are raising a bid, raise by a **multiple of the defined increment** for that event. Events raise by a \$2 or \$5 increment.
6. **Do not erase, cross out or in any other way change an entered bid.** See point #1! If you decide to raise your bid while a previous bid of yours is still in play, ask a volunteer wearing a chef's hat to cross out the previous bid for you.
7. **CALENDARS and PAYMENTS: Check your calendars before bidding.** If you win an event seat/spot but then find you are unable to attend, **honor the hosts by gifting or reselling your spot to a friend or family member.** No refunds will be given. All sales are final. **All payments are processed the week after the auction closes. No deferred payments.**
8. **TWO PLACES TO BID:** As mentioned above, make sure that you **don't bid for the same event online and oncampus** – the bids are completely separate and you might win in both places!
9. All proceeds from the Gourmets for God auction benefit the Center for Spiritual Living, Seattle.

Auction etiquette

Please honor the generous hosts who have planned and organized for months to offer you a fabulous experience! Imagine slicing and dicing for days, and setting a striking table for eight, and then two individuals just don't show up. It's heartbreaking! If you cannot attend an event, **please do everything possible to fill your seat** by gifting or selling the spot to another excited guest – they'll thank you for it!

Bidding/planning strategies

Make sure you have your calendar close when you're bidding. Some individuals like to spread their anticipated events throughout the year. Others like to bunch them up – two or three events on one weekend – so their other weekends remain free for travel, etc!

Keep an eye on your bids – if one event gets a bit “spendy” and you no longer wish to continue bidding on it, knowing this early gives you time to get in on another event! (It can be very disappointing to get excited about your potential events, and then get outbid on them, and end up with nothing...)

Note: *All auction events assume no smoking, no alcohol served, no pets, not handicap accessible (ADA), unless otherwise indicated in the item information.*
