3. Turn left on to NE 70th St and then turn left again into the Administrative Building Parking lot.

## GUIDE TO FILLING OUT PAPERWORK

CONGRATULATIONS! We are excited and honored to be officiating your marriage at The Big Gay Wedding. This is a historic and important step in the lives of all Washington State same-sex couples.

To make sure your marriage ceremony runs smoothly I would like to review with you the documentation you will have received when you applied for your marriage license. **You must bring all your marriage paper work completed to the wedding ceremony.** The marriage cannot be done without it. In order to participate in The Big Gay Wedding, **you will need to have obtained your marriage license by December 12<sup>th</sup>**, to meet the three day waiting period before the marriage ceremony.

In order to expedite the processing of legal paperwork, prior to arriving for The Big Gay Wedding Ceremony on December 15<sup>th</sup>, 2012, we ask that you please fill out specific information on your license. The new same-sex Certificate of Marriage will not be available until the 6<sup>th</sup> of December, so the sample we have included does not reflect the final exact wording of the document, but it will give you a general guideline for how to fill out the form as follows:

**County License** – Please enter the beginning and ending validity dates indicated on your license.

**Officiant Section** – Please skip this section. It will be filled out by the officiant of your marriage

**Groom (Old Form)** – This will likely now say **Spouse One**

Please fill out this section in its entirety. **DO NOT SIGN OR DATE UNTIL DIRECTED BY OFFICIANT**

**Bride (Old Form)** – This will likely now say **Spouse Two**

Please fill out this section in its entirety. **DO NOT SIGN OR DATE UNTIL DIRECTED BY OFFICIANT**

**Turn the form over** and include your social security numbers on the back. If you do not have one, please sign your name and date it.

When you arrive for your registration at The Big Gay Wedding please give your legal paperwork to The Big Gay Wedding registrant. It will be returned following the ceremony when you will be directed to date and sign the legal document. All your legal documents will be witnessed by The Big Gay Wedding officiating staff. You do not need to secure witnesses for these documents.

You will also receive a **Certificate of Marriage** issued by Washington State and King County. Please fill out the marriage license date, the date of the wedding, the 2:00 pm time, and the County of King. You may fill out both your names. **Please do not fill out Witnesses, Parties, or Officiant information.**

Following the marriage ceremony you will **return to the registration area** to complete and sign your paperwork and receive your completed commemorative Certificate of Marriage.

As in all weddings, **the return of all completed legal documents to the State and County is the responsibility of your marriage officiants.** That will hold true for The Big Gay Wedding and will be done the following Monday, Dec 17, 2012.

## **THE BIG GAY WEDDING PHOTOGRAPHY**

The Center for Spiritual Living has arranged with David Peterson and Classic Image Photography to handle all photography activities for The Big Gay Wedding. David and his team will be providing several opportunities to capture moments and memories of the wedding for our couples.

Upon arrival and completion of your registration process, you will be invited to pose for a traditional couple's wedding shot. Additionally, each couple will be photographed making their way into Celebration Hall during the processional. Following the ceremony and the completion of your paperwork, David will also provide you and "family" members and opportunity to pose for a post-marriage photo in the Celebration Hall.

David and his team will also be shooting candid shots of couples, the crowd, and the marriage ceremony experience. Classic Image Photography will post all photos on their website where an "easy to order" process will allow you to choose whatever images you want.

## ETIQUETTE/GROUND RULES

### DRESS/APPEARANCE

The Big Gay Wedding is intended to be celebratory and sacred, a serious yet joyful experience for the marriage couples and their loved ones. While Pride Festivities are expressive and “anything goes,” The Big Gay Wedding is a more reserved, formal event, a shared experience for all those present. There will also be local and national members of the press present, capturing images and impressions that will reach millions. We encourage everyone, marriage couples and their guests, to look and be at their best, so that everyone can look back on this day with joy, pride, and gratitude.

We reserve the right to turn anyone away who is inappropriately dressed, or to request different clothing be worn.

### GUEST SEATING

All guests will need to present their tickets (enclosed) at the entrance to the Celebration Hall auditorium. Guests with tickets will be seated on the lower level of the Celebration Hall, so they will have the closest seating to the marrying couples. On each ticket is listed the couple number the guest is there for. A seating chart will be provided to show approximate location of the marriage couples during the ceremony, so that guests may try to sit near their marriage couple. **Specific seating is not guaranteed. Doors open at 12:30pm. Guests are requested to be seated by 1:30pm.**

Due to the large number of couples participating in The Big Gay Wedding and space restrictions, we ask you to please let your guests and family members know that they will not be able to leave their seats to take individual pictures of you once the ceremony has begun nor will they be allowed in the registration and pre-wedding hospitality areas where you will be assembling prior to the processional. Any areas the couples will be using will be off-limits to family and friends prior to the ceremony. This will allow the privacy of all the couples to be respected and honored.

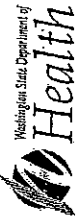
